Dr. Henry Cloud and Dr. John Townsend said in their book Raising Great Kids:

- 1. Some things are dangerous; Stay away from them, or you will die
- 2. Some things are not wise; do not do them, or you will lose
- 3. Some things are not moral; Avoid them and you will win
- 4. You are in charge of all of the above until you prove that you cannot be, and them we or the law will intervene.

Dara's 10 Steps to Raising Teenagers and Young Adults

- 1. Pray
- 2. Know their foundation is firm
- 3. Know that their Father God loves them even more than you and has a purpose and a plan for them
- 4. Pray
- 5. Endure through the fire with them (Be there)
- 6. Celebrate victories
- 7. Ask questions (even the uncomfortable ones)
- 8. Discuss everything
- 9. Pray
- 10. Begin to let them go emotionally respect them and have healthy boundaries.
